This hearing could change your rights or your children's rights to support.

No attorney-client relationship exists between this agency and you or your children. Because no attorney-client relationship exists, communications from you to the agency are not privileged.

No representation or relationship will arise because this agency provides services that you have requested.

This agency may provide support enforcement services to the other parent.
