

Legal parentage is easy to establish without going to court – *and it's free!*



What is POP?

The California Parentage Opportunity Program (POP) is a voluntary program for a birth parent and other parent to establish legal parentage free-of-charge.

What is the Uniform Parentage Act?

Effective January 1, 2020, the Uniform Parentage Act allows more people to utilize the Parentage Opportunity Program, reflecting the diversity of California families.

Completing a Voluntary Declaration of Parentage

In most cases, a signed and filed Voluntary Declaration of Parentage (VDOP) has the same force and effect as a judgement for parentage issued by a court.

Birth Certificate

A birth certificate does not legally establish parentage, and filing a VDOP will not automatically change the name on a birth certificate.
